

## New York State Snowmobile Safety Education Program Course Permission Statement for students ages 10 through 17

(This may also be used as a registration form for adults taking the course)

This course is designed to fulfill safety certificate requirements. It is offered to those ages 10 through 17 and to adults that wish to receive a safety certificate.

New York State law requires youths ages 14 through 17 years of age to earn a safety certificate in order to gain the privilege of operating a snowmobile as an adult. Youth ages 10 through 13 may operate a snowmobile, on lands upon which snowmobiling is allowed, if they have completed a snowmobile safety training course recognized by the State of New York and are accompanied by ( within 500 feet of ) a person who is at least 18 years of age.

## Successful completion of this course requires the student to:

- 1. be at least 10 years old (on or before the day the course ends)
- 2. attend class sessions
- 3. complete the workbook accurately
- 4. receive a score of 75% or better on the final examination

## Only those students meeting <u>all</u> of the above criteria will receive a New York State Snowmobiling Safety Certificate.

The course is taught by volunteer instructors who are experienced snowmobilers and have been certified as snowmobile safety trainers.
